Applicants must have the minimum qualifications & experience as indicated in the advertisement against each reflected post in the website www.highereducation.tripura.gov.in. Completed application in prescribed proforma along with self-attested photocopies of two sets of all credentials must reach the Office of the Officer-on-Special-Duty, MBB University by 31st October. 2016. In-service candidates shall apply through proper channel. No. TA/DA is admissible for attending the interview to be invited for the purpose. It should be noted that possession of minimum eligibility shall not confer any right to be called for interview. Incomplete applications will be rejected on scrutiny.  - (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
 - (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
 - (iv) A minimum score of 400 points of APIs as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as per UGC norms.

OR

B. An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

Essential Qualifications for the post of Associate Professors:

- (i) Good academic record as defined by the University with a Ph. D. Degree in concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with a least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/ industry excluding the period of Ph. D. Research with evidence of published work



- and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/ or research/policy papers.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum score of 300 points of APIs as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as per UGC regulations.

Essential Qualification for the post of Assistant Professors:

- i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks at Master's Degree level in relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared ii) the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC. Notwithstanding anything contained in the sub-clauses, (i) and (ii) to Clause 4.4.2.1 of UGC Regulation-2010, candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/colleges/Institutions.
- iii) NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for Masters Programmes in such disciplines also for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Relaxation allowed

- (i) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Master's level for the SC/ST/Differently-abled (Physically handicapped) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. Rounding off of marks to make it to 55% or 50% as the case may be through grace mark procedure etc., by university is not permissible for claiming relaxation.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D Degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
 - Holders of Ph.D degree as on the date of Notification of the UGC Regulations, 2009 (i.e. 23-09-2009) along with those candidates who were awarded a Ph.D degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the UGC (minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree), Regulations, 2009 and so adopted by the University, shall be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Maximum age limit for Professors / Associate Professors as on the last date of receiving applications are:

Maximum 55 years. (Relaxable by 5(five) years in case of SC/ST/PH candidates and Government servants. However, the SC/ST/Govt. Servant will not get the further relaxation of 5(five) years over and above relaxation of 5 (five) years which they are already entitled to get as SC/ST candidates).

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Maximum age limit for Assistant Professors as on the last date of

receiving applications are:

Maximum 40 Years. (Relaxable by 5(five) years in case of SC/ST/PH candidates and Government servants. However, the SC/ST/Govt. Servant will not get the further relaxation of 5(five) years over and above relaxation of 5 (five) years which they are already entitled to get as SC/ST candidates).

Note:

1. Period of time taken by the candidates to acquire M. Phil and / or Ph. D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the post of Professor/ Associate Professor.

2. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) may be considered while

deciding on the selection criterion.

3. Candidates applying for the posts of Associate Professors and Professors are requested to submit Self-Assessment for their Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) in the format of UGC along with the application.

4. Application will be received in hard copies only and no online application

will entertained.
