The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) is implementing the **National Mission on Himalayan Studies (NMHS)** through different research institutions/organizations. Doon University has been awarded several **Research Positions** for a period of 3 years (2016-2019). **Currently, 8 JRFs positions are available.**

Doon University is looking for bright candidates from **Environmental, Forestry, Biological, Physical Sciences** and the related disciplines for filling up the following positions: **Himalayan Junior Research Fellows (H-JRF) 8 (eight)** for the duration 2016-2019. Applications are invited from Indian citizens who are keenly interested to work for the Himalayan ecosystem and willing to take up field assignments of longer duration in the Himalayan region. Recruitment process

The selection of Himalayan Junior Research Fellows (H-JRFs) will be through a personal interview by the Selection Committee. **Candidates who have cleared UGC/CSIR NET-JRF will be preferred.** If the number of candidates is large, a written test might be conducted for screening purpose. In case, written test conducted, the syllabus of exam will be based on UGC-NET Environmental Science syllabus.

(i) *Candidates should send their advanced copy of application in prescribed format (download the application format from the doonuniversity.org website) by e-mail to nmhs@doonuniversity.ac.in till 10th October 2016 by 17:00 hours. The application fee of Rs. 300/- should also be sent by Demand Draft to “The HOD, SENR-School of Environment & Natural Resources, #110, Faculty Office, Doon University, Dehradun 248001”. The DD should be in favour of “Doon University”, payable at “Dehradun”. Candidates must mention the **Project name and Position applied for** in their applications. In the application, a candidate must mention his/her priority for the positions as indicated in the table of JRF positions in this advertisement. The "NET" qualified candidate should mention it clearly the appropriate section.*

Candidates must fill the application form very carefully. The application must be filled against the advertisement no. DU/NMHS/Fellowships/2016/2. Form not filled correctly will be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

(ii) The University shall screen the applications received by due date and organize interview for the short-listed candidates. The list of shortlisted candidates will be displayed on the Doon University website (doonuniversity.org) under "recruitment" section with the date of interview. The candidates are advised to check the website regularly for the updated information.

Shortlisted candidates will have to produce original certificates cited in their applications at the time of interview, without which they will be disqualified. Mere fulfillment of the minimum advertised qualification and experience requirement DOES NOT automatically entitle an applicant to be called for written interview. The decision of the University in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of application, mode of selection will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained from any individual or his/her agency.
