#### The Advertisement is as per UGC/RCI Regulations, 2010

- a) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks, at the Masters Degree level to the candidates belonging to the SC/ST/Differently abled (physically and visually differently-abled) categories.
- b) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks, to the Ph.D., Degree holders who have passed their Masters Degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September 1991.
- c) Candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D., Degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D., Degree) Regulations 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET / SLET / SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.
