GUIDELINES AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE TEACHING POSITIONS ADVERTISED

1. Qualification and Experience

(I) ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (Except Business Administration / Management)

- (a) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian University/Foreign University.
- (b) NET / SLET is the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment for appointment of Assistant Professor provided, however, the candidates, who are or have been awarded PhD degree in compliances of the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of PhD degree) Regulation 2009, amended in 2013 and 2016 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET / SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.
- (c) Without Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (a) and (b), the candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or the subsequent Regulations if notified by the UGC, shall be exempted from the requirement of the Minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions.

As per the amended UGC Regulations 2016 and subsequent amendments, if any, the Ph.D. Degree holders registered prior to 11th July, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of "NET/SLET/SET" for recruitment and appointment of Lecturer/Assistant

Professor or equivalent positions in University subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (i) Ph.D. degree of the candidate must have been awarded in regular mode only.
- (ii) Evaluation of the PhD thesis must have been done by at least two External Examiners.
- (iii) Candidate should have published at least two research papers out of which at least one in a referred journal from his/her Ph.D. works.
- (iv) The candidates should have presented two papers in seminars / conferences based on his/her PhD work.
- (v) Open PhD viva-voce of the candidate must have been conducted.

N.B. From point (i) to (v) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor / Pro-Vice-Chancellor / Dean (Academic Affairs) / Dean (University Instructions / Chairman, P. G. Council, and same shall be communicated by the Registrar.

(II) ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION / MANAGEMENT

A. Essential

1. First class master Degree in Business Administration/Management/in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full-time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/ accredited by the AICTE/UGC.

or

First class Graduate and professionally qualified charted accountant/ Cost& works Accountant/Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

- 2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for Lecturer/Assistant Professor conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar tests accredited by UGC like SLET/SET etc.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause 1 and 2, the candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or the subsequent Regulations if notified by the UGC, shall be exempted from the requirement of the Minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions.

As per the amended UGC Regulations 2016 and subsequent amendments, if any, the Ph.D. Degree holders registered prior to 11th July, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of "NET/SLET/SET" for recruitment and appointment of Lecturer/Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

B. Desirable

- 1. Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
- 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or published in refereed journals.

General Instruction

- 1. A relaxation of 5% of the marks at the master's level (from 55% to 50%) may be provided for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe / Persons with Disabilities category.
- 2. A relaxation of 5% of the marks (from 55% to 50%) may be provided to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 3. A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Assistant Professor may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF Examination conducted by UGC / CSIR only prior to 1989 when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF Examination were 50%.
- 4. NET/ SLET/ SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programs in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC/CSIR.

- 3. Age of Superannuation: 60 Years

5. How to apply

Online applications may be filled in and submitted there in. The online application procedure will commence from **28 May 2018** and last date for filling up of online application form is 2345 hours of **27 June 2018**. However, the last date of receipt of online printed application along with required documents is **4 July 2018**.

5. Documents to be submitted along with application forms

- (a) Self-attested photocopies of certificates and mark sheets of all examinations passed.
- (b) Self-attested photocopies of certificates for claiming any types of reservations.
- (c) API score certified by the competent authority.
- (d) Proof of payment of application fee.
- (e) Photocopies of other achievements and research work.
- (f) Candidates who are in-service can send their applications as Advance Copy in order to save delay. They have to ensure that the 'proper channel' application will follow it.

6. Other Conditions

- (a) Candidate intending to apply for different posts are required to apply separately.
- (b) No TA/DA will be paid to attend the selection committee or to join the first appointment.
- (c) Canvassing in any form by or on behalf of the candidate will be considered as a ground for disqualification.
- (d) Applications received incomplete in any respect are liable to be summarily rejected and no correspondence on that score shall be entertained.
