#### **Conclusion of the Process of Receiving Part-II Online Applications**

The Process of filling the Part-II (Final) Online Application Form by the Candidates who are going to participate in PMT / PET in the ongoing Recruitment Process started at 10 a m on 29<sup>th</sup> October (Monday), continued for the past 21 days and is going to conclude within a few hours today i.e., 18<sup>th</sup> November 2018 (Sunday) at 12 midnight. Candidates who qualified in the 4 (four) Preliminary Written Tests (PWTs) that were conducted on

26<sup>th</sup> August 2018 for SCT SI Civil and / or equivalent Posts,

9<sup>th</sup> September 2018 FN for the Posts of SCT SI IT&C,

9<sup>th</sup> September 2018 AN for the Posts of SCT ASI FPB and

30<sup>th</sup> September 2018 for SCT PCs Civil and / or equivalent Posts

and all those Candidates who applied for the 231 vacancies of SCT PCs Technical (IT&C, PTO Drivers and PTO Mechanics) have been filling their Part-II Online Applications along with uploading the photocopies of the relevant Certificates / Documents by logging on into their User Accounts on the TSLPRB Website [www.tslprb.in](http://www.tslprb.in), during the past 21 days.

At 6 p m today, with just 6 hours remaining before conclusion of the process, nearly 93% Candidates have already filled their Applications and the details are as follows –

By the above, it is clear that almost all the Candidates who are supposed to fill their Part-II Online Applications would have completed it by midnight (tonight).

### **Additional 3 Days for Filing Part-II Online Applications on 22<sup>nd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> November**

In spite of the vast majority of the Candidates completing the process smoothly as delineated above, there have been instances that were brought to the notice of the Board by individual applications / petitions from several Candidates that they had earlier (in Part-I Online Application) chosen their Community / Caste or Gender or Ex-Serviceman Status erroneously, with requests for modification in their data. For the past 21 days, Board has done hundreds of such modifications that were requested for by these Candidates, *after making all due verifications*. As a result, barring a few, almost all these Candidates were able to complete the filling-up of their individual Online Part-II Application Forms.

Consequent to the modifications done to the erroneously claimed Ex-Servicemen Status (especially belonging to Other Communities and Backward Classes) or in some instances – Community Status, certain Candidates who qualified in the PWTs earlier are disqualified now as they got less marks than the minimum marks of qualification designated for their Community. All such changes in the Status of Qualification are being issued as Corrigenda and are being published in the Login Area of the Candidates in the TSLPRB Website [www.tslprb.in](http://www.tslprb.in). Individual Candidates who are getting affected are also being informed in change of their Qualification Status through text messages on their Registered Mobile Numbers.

In this regard, keeping in view the interests of those very few Candidates who might not be able to complete the process by 12 midnight (tonight), *mainly because of their last-minute requests made to the Board for modifications in their data etc.*, it has been decided to give them a chance to fill their Part-II Online Applications for 3 days, from 8 a m on 22<sup>nd</sup> November (Thursday) to 12 midnight on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2018 (Saturday).

During the procedure, the Candidates are advised to take personal care while typing or choosing various entries in the Application Form and in ensuring that only photocopies of their relevant Documents / Certificates are uploaded at the appropriate slots / places. Candidates are cautioned not to leave it to Operators of Photocopy / Net Centres. They may take the assistance of the Operators of Photocopy / Net Centres, yet, they should be personally present and see to it that right information and uploads are provided in their Online Applications.

### **Opportunity to Candidates – to Edit Part-II Application Data**

The Board is aware that certain erroneous entries / uploads have been made by a few Candidates while filling their Part-II Online Applications. In this regard, Candidates are advised not to approach the Board at this stage through requests either in writing or by mails / messages. **All those parameters that have a bearing on the evaluation / qualification of each individual Candidate, till the conclusion of the Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test, have already been taken care of by TSLPRB.** Also, Candidates are likely to be given a chance to modify / correct the erroneous entries / uploads, if any, made by them – at an appropriate time by ‘Edit Option’ or otherwise. Therefore, Candidates are advised to not worry about these errors / mistakes as long as they do not have anything to do with their evaluation in the PMT / PET.

### **Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test from 17<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

PMT / PET will be conducted at **4 Venues / Grounds in Hyderabad** (for Hyderabad and erstwhile RR District Candidates), at **2 Venues / Grounds in Warangal** and at 1 Venue / Ground in each of the Headquarters of the other erstwhile Districts of **Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahbubnagar, Nalgonda, Sangareddy, Adilabad and Nizamabad** and this process is likely to be completed within a period 35-40 working days.

Admit Card for the PMT / PET Process will be issued through our Website *shortly*. More details on PMT / PET will be informed in due course. However, at this stage, Candidates are being informed that they will be allowed to participate in the PMT / PET only on

- Producing the Admit Card
- Satisfying the Biometric Verification of Identity
- *Where relevant* – Submission of Self-Attested Photocopy of the Community Certificate (Issued by Competent Authorities of Government of Telangana)
- *Where relevant* – Submission of Self-Attested Photocopy of Ex-Serviceman Certificate / No-Objection Certificate (by Personnel yet to be discharged)
- *Where relevant* – Submission of Agency Area Certificate by Aboriginal ST Candidates (Issued by Competent Authorities of Government of Telangana)
