With reference to our Press Notes dated 7th and 11th December 2018 on the subject of conduct of the Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test (PMT / PET) in the ongoing Recruitment Process, the Candidates are hereby informed that PMT / PET is now scheduled to be conducted from 11th February 2019 onwards, with revised dates for each Candidate, in all the Venues notified earlier *except* <u>2</u> Venues that are now deleted viz., Goshamahal, Hyderabad and KU Grounds, Warangal. In these circumstances, <u>Candidates have to necessarily download their Revised</u> <u>Admit Cards / Intimation Letters to be able to continue to participate in the Recruitment</u> <u>Process</u>. The details are as follows –

Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test from 11th February 2019

PMT / PET will be conducted at **3 Venues / Grounds in Hyderabad** (for Hyderabad and erstwhile RR District Candidates) and at 1 Venue / Ground in each of the Headquarters of the other erstwhile Districts of **Warangal, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahbubnagar, Nalgonda, Sangareddy, Adilabad and Nizamabad** and this process is likely to be completed within a period <u>35-40 working days</u>, by the third week of March 2019.

Revised Admit Cards / Intimation Letters Downloadable Between 5th and 9th February

All the Candidates who have qualified for PMT / PET are informed that their individual Revised <u>Admit Cards / Intimation Letters can be downloaded from 8 a m on 5th February 2019</u> <u>onwards till 12 midnight on 9th February 2019</u> by logging into their respective user accounts on the TSLPRB website: *www.tslprb.in* by entering their credentials. Instructions to Candidates

After downloading the Revised Admit Card / Intimation Letter, Candidates <u>shall take a printout</u> of the same, preferably on A4 size paper. Admit Card / Intimation Letter has 2 parts, <u>the top portion</u> having details of Date and Venue, Candidate Particulars and details of List of Documents to be submitted at the PMT / PET Venue <u>must be preserved till the final conclusion of the process of Recruitment</u>. The <u>bottom portion</u> of the Admit Card / Intimation letter is a Check Slip which will be taken away by the Representative Officer of the Chief Superintendent of Examination (<u>along with Print-Out of Part-II Application and Self Attested</u> <u>Photocopies of the Relevant Certificates submitted by each Candidate</u>) at the time allowing the Candidate to register for PMT / PET on the date of the Physical Examination.

Candidates *shall* bring along the following documents (<u>whichever are relevant</u>) to the Venue of PMT / PET without fail, as *these are essentially required for their registration for the Physical Test* –

- 1. Admit Card / Intimation Letter, preferably in A4 Size
- 2. Print-Out of the Part-II Application duly signed by the Candidate
- 3. Self-Attested Photocopy of Community Certificate issued by Government of Telangana
- 4. Self-Attested Photocopy of **Ex-Serviceman** / **No-Objection Certificate** (by Personnel yet to be discharged)
- 5. Self-Attested Photocopy of Agency Area Certificate for Aboriginal ST Candidates issued by Government of Telangana

<u>Candidates are advised to visit their Venue of PMT / PET one day prior to the actual Date of</u> <u>Examination and make sure about the Venue</u>. No traveling expenses will be paid for the journey, if any performed, to take the Test.

Candidates are advised to <u>be punctual in reporting at the Venue at the Time and on the Date given</u> <u>in their Admit Card</u>. If any Candidate fails to do so, it will be presumed that he / she is not interested in participating in further process of recruitment and his / her candidature will automatically lapse.

Candidates are advised <u>not to bring any unnecessary personal belongings to the Venue</u> of PMT / PET as such material may become a hindrance to their effective participation in the PMT / PET. Candidates, particularly women are advised not to come for the examination wearing jewelry or carrying handbags / *jholas* / pouches etc. *No Cloak Room / Storage Facility to safeguard any valuables or belongings of the Candidates is available at the Examination Centres.*

There will verification of identity of each Candidate based on the Biometric Data available with TSLPRB before permitting them to undergo the PMT / PET at all Venues. Therefore, <u>Candidates are advised</u> not to have mehendi, temporary tattoos or any obstructive material-covers on their fingers which may hamper the verification of Biometrics.

Adoption of any kind of unfair means or any act of impersonation during the PMT / PET will render the Candidate liable for invalidation of his / her candidature as well as appropriate criminal action.
