No. 7/1/2019-MPSC(DR): In continuation of this Commission's notification dated 26th March, 2019, it is hereby informed to all concerned candidates of Manipur Civil Services Combined Competitive (Preliminary) Examination, 2019 that Differently Abled Person who are eligible to avail compensatory time of 40 (forty) minutes for each paper as per existing rules are required to submit their certificates of disability where dominant (writing) extremity is affected to the extent of slowing the performance of function (minimum 40% impairment) issued by the competent authority to the Registrar, MPSC on or before 22nd April, 2019 or by email [manipurpsc@live.com]

- Differently Abled Persons like the Hearing Impaired candidates or others who 2. are not eligible to avail compensatory time, as per rule, need not submit their certificates of disability.
- 3. Only those candidates who submit the above mentioned certificate will be considered for the compensatory time of 40 (forty) minutes for each paper as per existing rules, if found eligible.
