	The system will take around 1-3 days for verification of payment made by the candidates. Ans	In case, there is a mismatch in names (including the way it is written), in GATE/SAIL application with that of a document like Class X/XII/ graduation mark-sheet, the onus will be on the candidate to establish that both the persons are same. If SAIL is not satisfied with the explanation/proof provided, the candidature will be rejected.
Qn.	Do I need to mail my complete application form with photograph affixed?
Ans	No. Completed application need not to be mailed. The application is to be brought at the time of GD/Interview, if shortlisted.
