The in-service Judicial Officers have been permitted to participate in the Viva-Voce without taking any decision on their eligibility and by participating in the process of Viva-Voce, no equity shall be created in their favour.

Hence, the aforesaid candidates are hereby directed to be present at **09.30 A.M.** on the respective dates before the Registrar General, High Court of Karnataka, Bengaluru, at their own cost. Further, they are requested to bring with them the following original certificates along with three sets of self-attested photocopies of the same, for verification:

- a) SSLC or equivalent examination certificate to show the Date of Birth and identity card for address proof.
- b) Degree, Law Degree Certificates/Marks Cards/Convocation Certificate.
- c) Enrolment Certificate as Advocate/Pleader, issued by the Bar Council.
- d) The in-service Judicial Officers shall produce the letter issued by the High Court for having permitted them to participate in the selection process of District Judges by direct recruitment and also produce the practicing certificate to show the number of years practised by them as an advocate before joining the judicial service.
- e) Certificate from the Presiding Officer of the Court in which the candidate is actually practicing or from the Registrar (Judicial)/Additional Registrar General, in case he/she is practicing in the High Court, indicating that he/she is a practicing Advocate and the length of his/her practice. The certificate shall indicate that he/she has been practicing for a period not less than seven years as on the last date fixed for submission of online application.

- f) The Public Prosecutors/Assistant Public Prosecutors-cum-Assistant Government Pleaders shall produce No Objection Certificate issued by the concerned Authority to permit them to apply for the post of District Judges by direct recruitment.
- g) If claiming reservation under SC/ST/Other Backward Classes, Rural/Kannada Medium/Ex-Servicemen or any other category, the requisite Certificates in proof thereof issued by the Competent Authorities.
- h) Candidates claiming reservation under Ex-servicemen are required to furnish certificate of release or discharge from Military service.
- i) List of cases conducted independently during the last three years with particulars of such cases.
- j) Two character certificates of good character (one from the Principal of the Institution/College in which the candidate has last studied with study details and another from a respectable person not being a relative who is well acquainted with him/her).
- k) Income Tax return, if any, to show the Annual income from the profession during the preceding three years.
