Annexure-4

General Instructions on Payment of Examination Fee and Claiming Age Relaxation

1. Examination Fee is Rs.500/- from each candidates. SC/ST /PwD/EWS Categories of candidates are exempted from payment of Examination Fee.
2. SC/ST Candidates with PwD can claim Age Relaxation as applicable to normal PwD candidates when they apply against UR Post in Pharmacist (Allopathic).
3. SC/ST candidates cannot claim Age Relaxation when they apply against UR post in Pharmacist (Allopathic)
4. OBC Candidates will have to make payment of Examination fee.
