The date of submission of online application is from 26.06.2020 to 02.07.2020. Applications sent by post will not be accepted.

Walk in interview for filling up the post of Sr. Residents will be held on 06.07.2020 at 11.30 hrs in Goonj Hall, Divisional Railway Manager's office, Mumbai Central, Mumbai. If number of candidates applied will be more, then specific date for interview will be communicated to candidates on Contact number given in Application form (In order to maintain social distancing)

Selection will be through the process of Walk-in Interview. After verification of Documents, only those candidates who are found eligible will be allowed to appear for Interview. All documents have to be produced in ORIGINAL at the time of Interviews along with the attested copies.

Eligibility Criteria:-

(a) Educational Qualification:

- (i) Post Graduate Degree recognised by MCI in the concerned Specialty,
- (ii) Post Graduate Diploma recognised by MCI In the concerned Specialty,
- (iii) Post PG Qualification for SR in Super specialty (G I Surgery & Gastroenterology & CVTS)
- (iv) The candidate should complete the tenure of PG Degree/ Diploma on or before the date of interview.
- (v) ONLY If candidates with PG Qualification are not available in a particular specialty, those without PG qualification but having at least three years experience after MBBS out of which one year of Junior Residency from a Government Hospital or MCI recognized private hospital in the concerned specialty, can be considered for a period of one year only.
- (b) **Registration**: Candidates must have a valid registration with Medical Council of India (MCI) / Maharashtra Medical Council (MMC) / State Medical Council.

Age Limit for appointment as Senior Residents:

☐ 45 years for those having Post Graduate/Post Doctoral Degree holders
☐ Relaxation for SC/ST/OBC and Physically handicapped as per government of Indian notification will apply.

Tenure of Senior Residency:

Tenure: Initial appointment will be for One Year only. This would be extendable to a total maximum period of three (03) years in the form of subsequent 2 annual extensions, subject to satisfactory work, conduct & performance.

Termination of appointment / Resignation can be done on one month prior notice or payment of one month salary from either side.

Emoluments:

For Senior Residents having Post Graduate degree

As per 7th pay commission Pay Matrix level 11

Approx Rs 1,15000/per month

Allowances:

PG allowance

For PG degree holder – Rs.200/- per month.

For PG Diploma holder – Rs.100/- per month.

This allowance is also already included in the total emoluments mentioned above. Hence, In case the Senior Resident is having only PG Diploma, a sum of Rs.100/- and in case he neither has PG Degree nor Diploma a sum of Rs.200/- per month will be deducted from his emoluments.

Accommodation

Residential unfurnished sharing accommodation would be provided to Senior Residents subject to availability. No HRA will be paid if accommodation is provided and license fee, electricity and water charges will be deducted from monthly emoluments.

Leave entitlements

• One day weekly off by rotation

• Entitled to total 20 days leave in one contract year which can be availed as not more than 10 in six months period.

• Not entitled to any vacation or any other type of leave.

Medical Treatment Facility

Free OPD treatment Medical facility as available in Railway Hospital will be provided to the Senior Residents for self, spouse & children .Free Indoor Medical treatment as available in Railway Hospital will be extended to self only in emergency and acute illness situation There shall not be any provision for referral to other Private Medical Centers for treatment.

Duties and Responsibilities

Duties and responsibilities of the Senior Residents will be as fixed by the Railway administration from time to time. They will be required to perform any work as may be needed in the legitimate interest of Railway administration including National Programmes or during Railway accidents, in addition to their specialty work.

No private practice shall be permitted

The candidates should bring all original documents along with a set of self attested photocopy of the same pertaining to age, qualification, MCI registration, work experience, caste etc. Letter of recommendation from Gaz Officer or satisfactory work report from previous employer is desirable. Attested Xerox copies of PAN, ADHAR Card, Caste certificate, two passport size photographs (updated and latest where ever applicable) should be brought on the date of walk in interview. (List of documents enclosed)

- 2. All the required certificates duly self attested must be attached with the application. The candidates must have their Original Certificates, Publications with them at the time of interview for verification by the office staff & to be shown to the Members of Selection Board if they desire so.
- 3. Please Note that any discrepancy pertaining to the documents may invite cancellation of offer of appointment as well as legal action under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code (IPC).
- 4. SC/ST candidates are required to submit their caste certificate (issued before the date of submission of their applications) issued only by the Authorized Competent Authority of the Maharashtra State Govt/Govt of India.
- 5. OBC candidates are required to submit their caste certificate (issued before the date of submission of their applications &but within ONE year from the date of Walk in Interview) duly mentioning about the Creamy Layer status)
- 6. EWS candidates are required to submit the certificate issued by the Competent authority ,issued within one year from the date of Walk in interview.
- 7. No TA/DA/ Allowances of any kind will be paid for appearing in the interview
- 8. The selected candidates will have to report for duty within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of the letter of offer. Candidature may be cancelled in case of not reporting within the prescribed time limit.
- 9. Any discrepancy may invite cancellation of appointment and legal action as per the rules. The Decision of the Selection Board will be final. In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction of court will be Mumbai only.
- 10.If any of the above post remain vacant ,walk in interview will be conducted on every first and third Thursday.
