Hence, the aforesaid candidates are hereby directed to be present at **01.00 P.M., on Friday, the 3rd July 2020** before the Registrar General, High Court of Karnataka, Bengaluru, at their own cost. Further, they are requested to bring their call letter and the following **original certificates** along with 3 sets of self-attested copies, for verification:

- a) SSLC or equivalent certificate in support of Date of Birth and Identity Card in support of address proof.
- b) Degree, Law Degree Certificates/Marks Cards/Convocation Certificate, in support of educational qualification.
- c) Certificate of Enrolment as Advocate/Pleader, issued by the Bar Council.

- d) Certificate from the Presiding Officer of the Court in which the candidate is actually practicing or from the Registrar (Judicial)/Additional Registrar General, in case he/she is practicing in the High Court, indicating that he/she is a practicing Advocate. The certificate shall also indicate that he/she has been practicing for a period not less than seven years as on the last date fixed for submission of online application.
- e) No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by the concerned authority for having permitted him/her to apply for the post of District Judge by direct recruitment, if he/she is working as Public Prosecutor/Assistant Public Prosecutor-cum-Assistant Government Pleader.
- f) Certificates obtained within the stipulated period from the competent authorities, if claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC, Rural candidate/Ex-servicemen or any other category.
- g) Creamy Layer Certificate, if claiming reservation under General Merit (Rural) category.
- h) Certificate of release or discharge from military service, if claiming reservation under Ex-servicemen category.
- i) List of cases conducted independently during the last three years with particulars of such cases.
- j) Two character certificates of good character (one from the Principal of the Institution/College in which he/she has last studied with study details and another from a respectable person not being a relative who is well acquainted with him/her).
- k) Income Tax return, if any, to show the annual income from the profession during the preceding three years.

Further, in view of Covid-19 pandemic, the candidates are required to follow the Special Instructions as at Annexure while appearing for Viva-Voce, without fail.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Candidates who are from the Containment Zone or who had primary/secondary contact to any *COVID-19 PATIENT* should submit their Covid-19 Reports and other candidates shall submit self declaration that they are not from the Containment Zone or they had not primary/secondary contact with any *COVID-19 PATIENT*.
2. Candidates are advised to download and install the 'Arogya Setu App' (http://play.google.com/store/apps/details?hl=en_IN), 'Apthamitra App' and 'Quarantine Watch App' in their Mobile and also ensure that Location and Bluetooth is turned on at all the time when they are in the High Court premises.
3. The entry and exit of candidates who are attending the viva-voce shall be only through Gate No.03 near High Court Post Office.
4. Candidates only are allowed to enter the High Court premises just before the scheduled time on production of their call letters for viva-voce.
5. In view of current Covid-19 situation, the candidates traveling overnight by buses and trains, are advised to wear clean and fresh clothes in order to maintain personal hygiene.
6. Candidates entering the High Court premises are instructed to co-operate with Medical Screening team and Para Legal Volunteers.
7. Mandatory Thermal Screening of all candidates will be done while entering the High Court premises and the candidates who are found to have above normal body temperature will not be allowed to enter the premises of the High Court and the decision of the Hon'ble District Judges Recruitment Committee in this regard is final.
8. Candidates entering the High Court premises shall wear fresh face mask throughout their stay in the High Court premises.
9. Candidates shall wear hand gloves at the time of submitting their documents for verification and shall use hand sanitizer.

10. At the time of verification of original documents, candidates shall maintain 6 feet distance while interacting with the High Court officials.
11. Candidates shall strictly follow social distancing norms during their stay in the premises of the High Court.
12. Candidates shall make necessary arrangements with regard to water bottle and packed food for their own consumption as no canteen facility is available in the High Court.
13. Candidates are requested to leave the High Court premises immediately after the completion of viva-voce.
