KIND ATTENTION: CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF PHARMACIST, POST CODE-02/18 IN HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT

The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. 02/2018 had advertised a total of **251 vacancies** [UR – 06, OBC-146, SC-55, ST-44 including PH (OH)-40, ExSM-111] for the post of **Pharmacist, Post Code- 02/2018 in Health & Family Welfare Department** with closing date as 13.08.2018. Online Tier-I examination was conducted on **01/11/2019 & 04/11/2019**.

2. **All 6350 candidates** who had appeared in written examination were informed through notice No. F.No. 233/Result/Pharmacist/Int. Cell/DSSSB/2019-20/1329-38 dated 18/03/2020 on the Board's website i.e. www.dsssb.delhi.gov.in that their marks for the examination dated 01/11/2019 & 04/11/2019 for the post of **Pharmacist, Post Code-02/18** have been declared and the same were available in their account in OARS module. Further, vide said notice, **270 shortlisted** candidates who qualified the written examination were given the opportunity to upload their documents in the e-dossier module **w.e.f. 24.03.2020 to 07.04.2020** with the specific direction that if any candidate fails to upload the e-dossier during the above said period, his/her candidature will be rejected and no further opportunity for uploading e-dossier will be given on whatsoever ground. The shortlisted candidate has uploaded his documents in the e-dossier portal.

3. On the basis of marks secured in the written examination and after preliminary scrutiny as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post and the terms and condition of the advertisement, the following **85 candidates (UR/PH/OH-03, OBC-51, OBC/PH/OH-01, SC-20, SC/PH/OH-01, ST-09)** are provisionally nominated for the post of **Pharmacist, Post Code-02/18 in Health & Family Welfare Department** subject to their fulfilling all other conditions of eligibility and also correctness of the information furnished by the candidate in his online application form and e-dossier. Further, the candidature of the candidates who failed to upload their e-dossier w.e.f. 24.03.2020 to 07.04.2020 was rejected vide Rejection Notice No. 634 dated 15.06.2020.

4. Further, the Board as a matter of practice and as per the existing policy, after declaration of marks and short-listing of candidates, directs the shortlisted candidates to upload their documents onto their respective e-dossier module through their individual OARS login and password. All those candidates who fail to upload their documents during the stipulated time period of 15 (fifteen) days, their candidature are rejected through a 'Rejection Notice' and this policy of the Board has been upheld by the Hon'ble Courts from time to time.

5. However, the stipulated period of uploading of the e-dossier got scheduled during the period of lockdown w.e.f. 24.03.2020 to 18.05.2020 (date of first unlock) imposed due to COVID-19 pandemic by Govt. of India.

6. Further, a spate of representations have been received from such candidates seeking extension of time for uploading the documents and few of them have approached the Hon'ble

CAT as well, which in turn has disposed off such applications with directions to the Board to dispose of the applications by passing appropriate speaking orders.

7. Therefore, after due deliberations, it has been decided that in view of the extra-ordinary circumstances arising out of the COVID-19 pandemic, wherein the entire country had to be placed in a lockdown w.e.f. 24.03.2020(Midnight) to 18.05.2020 and all physical movement of citizens were curtailed and all markets/services closed by Govt. of India and it was declared illegal to make any kind of movement, the candidates too were legally bound not to make any physical access to the computers/internet etc., they were physically restrained to seek any access to internet service providers such as Cyber Cafes or such I.T enabled services. Keeping in view of this fact of lockdown, the candidates who failed to upload their e-dossier during lockdown period, are being allowed another opportunity because of the above referred extraordinary circumstances **w.e.f. 06/10/2020 to 15/10/2020. However, the same shall not be quoted as precedent for any other case whatsoever.**

8. Accordingly, keeping in view of the above decision taken by the Board, the **Rejection Notice No. 634 dated 15.06.2020** is hereby withdrawn and the candidature of the candidates who failed to upload their e-dossier during 24.03.2020 to 07.04.2020 is revived for the post of Pharmacist, Post Code-02/18 in Health & Family Welfare Department.

9. **The shortlisted candidates for the above mentioned post code who failed to upload their e-dossier are hereby informed to fill the e-dossier and upload all the documents of Educational/Professional Certificates/Degree and Mark sheets/Caste Certificate/Disability certificate/Proof of Govt. Servant/Ex. Servicemen/Admit Cards etc., as applicable in the E-dossier module in OARS link in his individual account in OARS module. Short listing is being made on the basis of marks obtained in Tier-I written examination (Objective-MCQ) for 200 marks.**

10. Kindly note that the opening /activation of e-dossier link shall be applicable to only those candidates who are in the consideration zone of selection and failed to upload their e-dossier w.e.f. 24.03.2020 to 07.04.2020.

11. **The e-dossier link shall be activated for a period of 10 days w.e.f. 06/10/2020 to 15/10/2020.**

12. The candidate uploading e-dossier should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility criteria as on the cutoff date, i.e **13.08.2018**. The shortlisted candidates are also being separately informed through SMS & E-Mail on their registered mobile number & e-mail id. as an additional facility. **If, the candidate fails to upload the e-dossier during the above said period, his/her candidature will be rejected and no further opportunity for uploading e-dossier will be given on whatsoever ground.**


13. Mere asking the candidate for uploading documents in the e-dossier module does not confer him any right to selection to the applied post. Final selection will be made purely on the basis of merit against the notified vacancies provided the candidate falling in the zone of consideration fulfills all the required eligibility conditions. **It is reiterated that if the candidate fails to upload his/her documents on or before the date as mentioned above he/she will not be given any further opportunity and his/her candidature will be treated as cancelled.**

14. While every care has been taken in preparing the list of shortlisted candidate, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any, detected at any stage.



15. The above short listing candidates for calling of e-dossier for the post of **Pharmacist, Post Code-02/18 in Health & Family Welfare Department** is subject to outcome of pending court case, if any.
