 level, in the subject Agrometeorology/Meteorology/Agronomy from a recognize
 university.
- ii. Candidates with Ph.D. /NET if available shall be given preference.

MAXIMUM AGE LIMIT :-

Maximum age as per Resolution No. 294 dated 07.01.2016 issued by General Administration Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna is as follows:-

a) Unreserved Category (Male) - 37 Yrs,

b) Backward Class and Extremely Backward Class (Male & Female) - 40 Yrs.

c) Unreserved Category (Female) - 40 Yrs,

d) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Male & Female) - 42 Yrs.

RESERVATION :-

- i. Reservation shall only be applicable to the original resident of Bihar State.
- Candidates seeking employment against reserved vacancies must submit respective caste/category certificate issued by the competent authority as per the rules of Bihar Government.
- iii. As per Circular No. 11/आ०नी०-I-11/2015 सा०प्रा० 2342 dated 15.02.2016 in case of unavailability of female candidate (UR-F, SC-F, EBC-F, BC-F) post shall be filled with male candidate of same category in the same transaction.
- iv. As per notification no. 11/310-10-1-03/2019 साоप्रा0 2623 dated 26.02.2019 of General Administration Department, Govt. of Bihar. - The University shall not be responsible under any circumstances for any sort of postal delay.

- Only the information / claim entered / mentioned in the application form alongwith supporting documents will be taken into account. Qualifications /eligibility conditions, and age will be considered only upto the last date for submission of application form i.e. 28.10.2020

SELECTION PROCESS :-

Academic Qualification, Experience, Recognition/Awards/Special Attainments, Publications and Extra-curricular activities together shall carry 80 marks and Interview shall carry 20 marks. The summary of marks distribution is given below:

In the event of total marks obtained by two or more candidates is same, the candidate having higher cumulative marks under Sl.No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria as above will be placed higher in the final merit list. Subsequently, in the event of

candidate having same cumulative marks under Sl.No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria, candidates who are older in age according to the date of birth will be placed higher in the final merit list and in the event of candidates having same date of birth, candidates whose name appear alphabetically first in Devnagiri Script will be placed higher in the final merit list.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS :-

- The candidates are required to send their filled Application Form addressing to Director Extension Education, Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour (813 210) Bhagalpur through Registered Post/Speed Post only.
- Before filling-up the Application Form, the candidates are advised to read General Instructions, Essential Qualification and Other Important Conditions carefully.

- 4. The University reserves the right to:

In case the information/ documents are found to be false /incorrect by way of omission or commission, the responsibility and liability shall lie solely with the candidate.
- 8. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.

- 10. The person appointed against post shall be governed by the guidelines of the scheme and amended from time to time. If person appointed in the scheme may be allowed to continue in the scale of Rs. Rs. 15,600-39,100/- GP Rs. 5400/- as per 6th CPC OR Proposed 7th CPC prorate Rs. 56,100-1,77,500with Dearness Allowances, House Rent Allowances. No other allowances are permissible in the scheme accept DA & HRA.
- Annual increment alongwith Service extension will be granted based on review of annual work performance.
- 12. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after issue of the appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidates.
- 13. The University shall not be responsible for any misplacement, omission etc. if two or more applications are put in one cover (envelop) by the candidate.
- 14. Recognised Institutions: Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas or certificates for various courses from institution not recognised by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi shall not be eligible for the posts advertised.
