The merit list of the candidates will be displayed in the University Website: (www. pjtsau.edu.in). During the preparation of merit list, in case more than one student secures the same combined score, the tie shall be resolved to decide the relative ranking by successively considering the following:

- i. The total marks secured in AGRICET & AGRIENGGCET 2020
- ii. The percentage of aggregate marks secured in the qualifying examinations i.e., Diploma in Agriculture / Diploma in Seed Technology / Diploma in Organic Agriculture or Diploma in Organic farming / Diploma in Agricultural Engineering.
- iii. SSC Overall Grade Point
- iv. If the tie still persists, the date of birth of the candidates concerned, the older being given preference over the younger.

Admissions will be made strictly as per the rule of reservation based on merit through the Entrance Test.
