No. and Date of Birth in the appropriate fields. However, candidates will be able to download their Admit cards for the PMT/PET only 07 (seven) days before his/her date of PMT/PET and after filling up the COVID Declaration Form truthfully. All efforts will be made to deliver SMS alert regarding the date, time and venue of PMT/PET to the registered mobile number of the candidates, but the Board shall not be responsible for any non-receipts of such SMS due to change in mobile number and/or technical reasons. Candidates are advised to report to the venue on the session mentioned in their Admit card and will not be entertained in another session. Candidates are directed to carry identical photographs along with proof of identity and other documents as mentioned in the Admit cards for PMT/PET.

Male Candidates are advised to appear before PMT/PET with a <u>clean shaven face</u> identical to the uploaded photograph of Application PDF unless there is an immediate bereavement in the family or any medical reasons with a valid medical certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner.

Wearing of 3 ply face mask is mandatory. No candidate shall be allowed to take part in the PMT/PET without wearing a fresh 3 ply mask and no further date of PMT/PET shall be fixed for such candidates. They are advised to report at the venue at the time mentioned in their Admit cards. Candidates are advised to report to the venue on the session mentioned in their Admit card and will not be entertained in another session. Candidate's body temperature & SPO₂ will be measured on his/her arrival at the entrance of the venue. Candidates with body temperature & SPO₂ which is beyond / below the normal reference level shall not be allowed to take part in the PMT/PET. The candidates are also advised to follow the instructions given on their Admit cards and visit the websites as mentioned above on a regular basis.
