The Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission has made all arrangements for conducting Mains Examination for Group-I Services (Notification No.27/2018) from 14.12.2020 to 20.12.2020 (7 Sessions) at 13 Districts of Andhra Pradesh and Hyderabad in 41 venues. Total candidates are 9679, out of which 8099 candidates have downloaded their hall tickets as on 12.12.2020. The list of venues is enclosed herewith. The timings of the examination are 10.00 am to 1.00 pm and time-table is as hereunder:

The candidates will be provided with the TABS and Question Papers will be arranged through online, which will appear on the screen, once the candidate logs in using credentials supplied at appropriate time before the commencement of the examinations. Question Papers (soft copy) are available in English and Telugu version. Candidates who intend to take examination in Urdu medium shall refer to the questions framed in English or Telugu version only. All the papers are of descriptive type and they shall be answered in the booklets (Answer Books) supplied by the Commission.

Candidates will be allowed into the venue duly following the Covid-19 guidelines.

- (a) Candidates are advised to bring their gloves, personal hand sanitizer and transparent water bottle. The Commission has also made arrangements for supply of sanitizer at the entry of the exam hall.
- **(b)** Due to Covid-19, candidates shall be allowed into the venue after verification of the original Photo ID of the individual from 8.45 AM to 9.30 AM (with a grace period of 15 minutes up to 9.45 AM). No candidate shall be allowed for the exam after expiry of the grace period. Photograph shall be captured instead of bio-metric during the registration process due to Covid-19.
- **(c)** Temperature of candidates shall be checked at the entry to the examination venue through Thermo Gun. If any candidates have symptoms of Covid-19, they shall be allowed to write the examination in an isolation room.

Candidates are not allowed to bring any electronic devices such as Mobiles, iPads, TABS, Calculators, Wrist Watches, Bluetooth, Pagers or any other device capable of interacting/programming, Handbags, Books, writing pads, etc into the Exam hall.

The candidates shall report at the venue as per the reporting time mentioned in the Hall Ticket along with any Original ID i.e., Passport, Pan Card, Voter ID, Aadhaar Card, Govt. Employee ID or Driving License etc. For PH candidates bringing Scribe, original ID of the Scribe and original disability certificate are to be brought.
