<b>ALL INDIA LAW ENTRANCE TEST (AILET)</b>	: <b>June 20, 2021 (10.00 am - 11.30 am)</b> (To be conducted offline, subject to revision)

The NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY DELHI established in 2008 by Act No. 1 of 2008 is premier Law University in the capital city of India. The University invites applications for admission to **B.A.LL.B.(Hons.)**, **LL.M.** and **Ph.D. Programmes** for the Academic Year 2021-22. Eligibility, total seats and other details for these Programmes are:

### **B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) [Five-Year Programme]**

**Eligibility:** Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2 System) or Equivalent Examination with 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST/Persons with Disabilities). The candidates appearing for the 12<sup>th</sup> standard annual examination in 2021 are eligible to apply.

**Total Seats: 110+10** (110 seats on AILET merit; 5 seats each for Foreign Nationals and OCI/PIO for direct admission on merit). Foreign Nationals/OCI/PIO are exempted from AILET, but should have 65% marks in the qualifying examination.

**Additional Supernumerary Seats:** One seat for Kashmiri Migrants and Two seats for Residents of Jammu & Kashmir.

### **LL.M. Programme [One Year]**

**Eligibility:** LL.B. or an equivalent law degree with 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/ Persons with Disabilities). The candidates appearing for final year LL.B. annual examination in 2021 are eligible to apply.

**Total Seats: 70+10** (70 Seats on AILET merit; 5 seats each for Foreign Nationals and OCI/PIO for direct admission on merit). Foreign Nationals/OCI/PIO are exempted from AILET.

**Note:** One additional supernumerary seat for Kashmiri Migrants.

### **Ph.D. Programme**

**Eligibility:** LL.M. or an equivalent law degree with 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/ Persons with Disabilities).

**Total Seats: 13+2** (13 Seats on AILET merit and 2 Seats for direct admission to Foreign Nationals on merit of Research Proposals). Foreign Nationals are exempted from AILET.

### **AILET-2021 will be conducted at the following cities:**

**Bengaluru, Bhopal, Chandigarh, Chennai, Cochin, Cuttack, Dehradun, Delhi, Gandhinagar, Greater Noida, Gurugram, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jammu, Jodhpur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur, Patna, Raipur, Silchar, Varanasi and Visakhapatnam.**

Interested candidates should apply online on payment of application fee of Rs.3,050/- (Rupees Three Thousand Fifty Only). Application fee in case of SC/ST and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) is Rs.1,050/- (Rupees One thousand Fifty Only). **Below Poverty Line (BPL) applicants of SC/ST category are exempted from application fee.**
