


**PRESS RELEASE**

As per the instructions of the Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada, all the RIOs are informed to follow the instructions given below for conduct of practical Examinations during March 2021. Inform the same to all the principals of Govt. / Aided / PVT Jr. Colleges in your jurisdiction.

- Practical Examinations are scheduled from 31-03-2021 to 24-04-2021 (including Sundays)
- Forenoon Session : 09.00 AM to 12.00 Noon.
- Afternoon Session : 02.00 PM to 05.00 PM.
- No. of Practical Examination Centres : 947.
- No. of Practical Examination centres Last Year : 905.
- No. of Practical Centres increased this year : 42.
- No. of Students appearing for Practical Examinations :  
MPC : 2,60,012 + BiPC : 98,462 = **Total: 3,58,474.**
- Chief Superintendent will be appointed for private unaided junior colleges from Govt. / Aided Junior colleges to monitor the conduct of Practical Examinations.
- Practical Examinations should be done under the surveillance of C.C. Cameras (All the four labs – Botany, Zoology, Chemistry & Physics).
- CC Footage will be verified if any complaints are received.
- Every day session wise OTP will be sent to the registered mobile number of the Chief Superintendent for opening the already downloaded Question Paper.
- Questions should not be altered in the down loaded question paper at any cost.
- The Practical Examiner appointed by the BIE should alone conduct the Practical Examination.
- Practical Examiners should report one session before.
- Practical Examiners not be given exemption from attending the duty without valid reasons.
- After completion of the session wise practical examination, the valued answer scripts. Original Award List and Duplicate Award List must be sealed in a cloth lined cover before the CC Cam.
- The Examination functionaries, students etc., who ever found responsible for any sort of malpractice in the examination centre are liable for punishment as per "The Andhra Pradesh Public Examinations (Prevention of Malpractices and Unfair Means) Rules 1997 (G.O Ms. No. 114 Education dated:13-05-1997 of Education (IE) Department Act 25/1997.
- Practical Record books should be punched with a nail in one or two places to avoid re use of the Record.
- Practical Record books should be kept session wise, Batch wise until the declaration of the Results.
- Instruct all the Examiners to deposit their cell phones with Chief Superintendent before entering the Examination hall.
- No one except the Chief Superintendent should use cell phones during the Examination.
- Students Batch should not be changed without prior permission from Board of Intermediate Education.
- No Physical Hall Tickets will be issued this year for IPE.
- Hall Tickets for Practical Examinations for Science students will be placed in "bie.ap.gov.in" website today.

- 1) Practical Examinations will be conducted in next available batch to students who suffers from COVID – 19.
  - 2) Instructions were issued to accommodate 10 members each out of 20 in a batch in a lab and the remaining 10 members in another room during the practical examination to avoid crowding if necessary.
