## **NOTIFICATION**

In continuation with Advt. No. 08/2020 vide letter No.23PSC/E-3/2020-21 dated 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 and subsequent notification No.88PSC/CON/Exam-18/2020-21 dated Guwahati the 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, attention is hereby drawn from the candidates who have qualified to appear in the Combined Competitive (Main) examination, 2020.

- 1. The Commission will hold the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 in the month of **January** tentatively at Guwahati centre only. Exact date will be notified in due course depending upon the outcome or further order(s) as may be passed by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court in the pending Writ Proceedings viz. W.P(C) 28/2021(Smti Bondita Borah vs State of Assam & ors), W.P(C) 5169/2020 (Navin Kr Ray Vs State of Assam & others) and W.P(C) No. 5248/2020 (Bonani Priya Rajkonwar vs State of Assam & ors).
- 2. The Roll No. of the candidate for the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 will remain the same as that of Combined Competitive (Prelim.) Examination, 2020.
- 3. Prescribed online application forms for the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 will be available in the Assam Public Service Commission's website <a href="https://www.apsc.nic.in">www.apsc.nic.in</a>. The Online Applications can be filled up from 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 to 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2021 till 5:00 P.M. after which the link will be disabled. Candidates must note the following:-
- i. The Candidates must read the 'Guidelines' and 'How to Apply' before filling up the application form.
- ii. The Commission will not receive any online application after the last date of submission of applications.
- iii. The candidates may download the syllabus for Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 from the Commission's website www.apsc.nic.in.
- iv. Candidates have to choose any one of the languages from Assamese/ Bengali/Bodo for Paper A of Qualifying Papers.
- v. Exemption from Paper A (Any one of the language from Assamese, Bengali, Bodo of Qualifying Papers): Candidates belonging to Dima Hasao, Karbi Anglong, West Karbi Anglong, Cachar, Karimganj and Hailakandi districts who did not have any of these languages in High School Leaving Certificate Examination shall be exempted from appearing in Paper A of Qualifying Papers.
  - N.B.:- Exemption of candidates from appearing in the Paper A (any one language from Assamese, Bengali, Bodo) of Qualifying Papers shall be subject to the outcome or further order(s) as may be passed by the Hon'ble Court, in the pending Writ Petitions viz W.P(C) 28/2021(Smti Bondita Borah vs State of Assam & ors), W.P(C) 5169/2020 (Navin Kr Ray Vs State of Assam & others) and W.P(C) No. 5248/2020 (Bonani Priya Rajkonwar vs State of Assam & ors).
- vi. Candidates have to choose any one optional subject among the list of 26 optional subjects mentioned in the Advt. No. 08/2020 vide letter No.23PSC/E-3/2020-21 dated 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2020.
- vii. Only those PWBD candidates who have earlier applied for Scribe at the time of Combined Competitive (Prelim.) Examination, 2020 will get Scribe for the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 upon application for the same addressing the Commission with valid documents as mentioned in the appendix-II and appendix-III (Candidates opting for own Scribe) of the Advt. No. 08/2020 before 15(Fifteen) Days of Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020. Candidates can send hard copy of their application to the Commission's office or email at apsc-asm@nic.in.

- viii. Candidates have to choose their order of preference(s) among the Services/Posts advertised through the Advt. No. 08/2020 vide letter No.23PSC/E-3/2020-21 dated 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2020. Candidature will be considered only for those cadres/posts that he/she have chosen while submitting the online application form for Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020.
  - ix. Scanned copies of the following documents are required to be uploaded while filling the online application form:
    - **1.** Age Proof: Matriculation / HSLC Admit Card / Certificate issued by a recognized Board/ Council.
    - 2. Educational Qualification: Degree certificate from any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess such qualification as may be declared equivalent by the Government.
    - 3. As per Govt. notification no.ABP.69/2019/17, dated 06/11/2019 candidates have to upload a declaration regarding "The Small Family Norms" in Form-A. Candidates may visit "Forms and Downloads" section of the Commission's website for proforma.
    - **4.** Caste Certificate: OBC/SC/ST (P)/ST (H) certificate issued by Govt. of Assam. (if applicable)
    - **5.** PWBD Certificate: Issued by competent authority. (if applicable)
    - 6. BPL certificate (if applicable).
    - 7. EWS certificate issued by competent authority. (if applicable)
    - **8.** Character Certificate from two respectable person of status not related to the candidate.
    - 9. Candidates belonging to Dima Hasao/Karbi Anglong/West Karbi Anglong Cachar/Karimganj/Hailakandi district who did not have any of these languages in High School Leaving Certificate Examination can claim exemption from appearing in the Paper-A of the Qualifying Papers. Such candidates need to upload Residency Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner/ SDO (Civil) of respective District/ Sub Division along with their HSLC Marksheet(s).

N.B:- Exemption of candidates from appearing in the Paper A (any one language from Assamese, Bengali, Bodo) of Qualifying Papers shall be subject to the outcome or further order(s) as may be passed by the Hon'ble Court, in the pending Writ Petitions viz W.P(C) 28/2021(Smti Bondita Borah vs State of Assam & ors), W.P(C) 5169/2020 (Navin Kr Ray Vs State of Assam & others) and W.P(C) No. 5248/2020 (Bonani Priya Rajkonwar vs State of Assam & ors).

NOTE: All candidates in Government service, whether in a permanent or in temporary capacity or as work charged employee, other than casual or daily rated employees or those serving under Public Enterprises will be required to submit an undertaking that they have informed in writing their Head of Office/Department that they have applied for the Examination. Candidates should note that in case a communication is received from their employer by the Commission withholding permission to the candidates applying for appearing at the examination, their candidature will be liable to be cancelled.

It should be noted here that all the details (viz. Category/Category certificate number/Date if issue, if applicable/Optional Subject/Choice of Cadre, etc) while submitting the online application must be correct in all respect and no request for changes shall be entertained by the Commission. The original copies of mark sheets / certificates shall be verified at a later stage to be notified by the Commission.

### x. FEES FOR MAINS EXAMINATION:

Under the Digital India initiative by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, APSC has decided to launch it's Online Recruitment portal with the help of CSC-SPV, a MeitY approved organization, which will charge a processing fee of Rs. 30/- + 18% tax = 35.40/- from each candidate.

# <u>Mode of Payment</u>: Candidate can pay their application fees through Internet Banking/Debit Card/ Credit Card only.

- xi. Candidates appearing in the examination should also bring with him/ her to the examination hall extra copies of the photograph similar to the one uploaded in the online application form.
- xii. The e-admit cards will be uploaded in the Commission's website. The candidates should download the same and check it carefully to ensure that the particulars on the e-Admit Card are correct. In case, there is any mistake in the e-Admit Card, it should be brought to the notice of the Commission with a request to issue the correct e-Admit Card. No candidate will be allowed to enter in to the examination hall without e-admit card.

### 4. If any candidate appears, —

- (i) at a centre other than the one as mentioned in his/her e-Admit Card; or
- (ii) in an optional subject other than the one as mentioned in his /her e-Admit Card; or
- (iii) in a language other than the one as mentioned in his/her e-Admit Card for qualifying paper-A.

PAPERS OF SUCH A CANDIDATE WILL NOT BE EVALUATED, AND THE CANDIDATURE WILL LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED.

### N:B:-

- 1. No change shall be entertained once online application is successfully submitted.
- 2. If any information submitted by the candidates while filling online application form for Combined Competitive (Prelm.) Examination, 2020 and Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2020 is found wrong/incorrect at any stage, his/her candidature will be liable to cancellation.
