- II. The candidates who are permanent residents of Assam should only apply for the posts of Assistant Professor & equivalent, which is as per the university service rule/ regulation


B. Submission of application forms:

Application form in prescribed format is to be submitted online at <http://www.aau.ac.in/teacher-recruitment> on or before the **4 PM** of **17-03-2022**

- i) Application fee is to be deposited on online mode only. The prescribed fee is Rs. 300/- in case of general candidates and Rs. 150/- in case of SC/ST/DAC/EWS candidates.
- ii) In-service candidates shall have to submit NOC from their parent Department/ Organization.
- iii) Reservation for ***Economically Weaker Section*** will be as per office memorandum no. ABP.07/2019/3 dated Dispur, the 2nd February, 2019 of the Dept. of Personnel, Personnel (B), Dispur, Guwahati, Govt. of Assam. The concerned candidates may apply alongwith the requisite documents accordingly.

C. Post under AICRP/ AINP in the rank of Junior Scientist & equivalent shall be Co-terminous in nature for which the selected candidates will be appointed as per the recommendation of the selection committee.
