#### ADVERTISEMENT NO. 02 OF 2023-24

Recruitment to the posts of Dental Surgeons in Group-A (Junior Branch) of Odisha Medical Services (Dental) Cadre, under Health & Family Welfare Department

Online applications are invited from the prospective candidates through the proforma application form to be made available on the Website of the Commission (<a href="http://opsc.gov.in">http://opsc.gov.in</a>). The link for online application and submission shall be available from 28.04.2023 to 29.05.2023 (Note: 29.05.2023 is the last date for submission of Registered Online Application) for recruitment to 197 (65-w) posts of Dental Surgeons in Group-A (Junior Branch) of Odisha Medical Services (Dental) Cadre, under Health & Family Welfare Department in the Level-12, Cell-1 of ORSP Rules, 2017 with usual dearness and other allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time. The posts are temporary and likely to be made permanent.

2. <u>Vacancy Position</u>: As per requisition filed by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Odisha, the vacancy positions along with reservation thereof are given below:

Out of 197 vacancies, **08 posts** [OA-03, OL-03 & BL(MNR)-02] are reserved **for PWD** candidates (whose permanent disability is 40% and more) and **02 posts** are reserved **for Sports Person** candidates. Persons With Disabilities & Sports Persons shall be adjusted against the categories to which they belong.

NOTE:

- (a) In the event of non-availability of sufficient number of eligible women candidate(s) belonging to any particular category, the vacancies or the remaining vacancies will be filled up by male candidate(s) of that category.
- (b) Exchange of reservation between Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe will not be considered in the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable S.C./S.T. candidates.
- (c) The number of vacancies to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by Government without notice, depending upon the exigencies of public service at the discretion of the State Government.
- 3. <u>AGE</u>: A candidate must have attained the age of 21(twenty one) years and must not be above the age of 38 (thirty eight) years on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2023 i.e. he/she must have been born not earlier than 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1985 and not later than 1<sup>st</sup> January 2002.

The upper age limit prescribed above shall be relaxed by 5 (five) years for candidates belonging to the categories of Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C), Scheduled Castes (S.C.), Scheduled Tribes (S.T.), Women & Ex-Servicemen and by 10 (ten) years for candidates belonging to PWD category, whose permanent disability is 40% and more.

Persons with Disabilities belonging to SEBC/SC/ST categories are eligible for age relaxation benefit of 15 (Fifteen) years.

Provided that, a candidate who comes under more than one category mentioned above, he/she will be eligible for only one age relaxation benefit, which shall be considered most beneficial to him/her.

SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

# 4. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

A candidate must:-

(i) have possessed a BDS or equivalent Degree from a Medical College or Medical Institution recognized by the Dental Council of India (DCI);

(ii) have possessed a valid Registration Certificate under the "Dentist Act- 1948";

Provided that if a candidate outside the State of Odisha has not registered his name under the Odisha Dental Council as per the provision of section 34 of Dentist Act, 1948, he shall get himself registered, before issue of appointment order.

(iii) have possessed required Conversion Certificates recognized by Dental Council of India (DCI) in case of candidate having degrees from universities of foreign countries.

- **EXAMINATION FEE:** The candidates are exempted for payment of examination fee as per G.A. & P.G. Department letter No. 9897/Gen., dt.11.04.2022.
- METHOD OF SELECTION: The selection of candidates for recruitment to the post of Dental Surgeon will be made as per the guidelines as enumerated in Odisha Medical Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Dental Surgeons) Rules, 2022.

The suitability of candidates shall be adjudged on the basis of written test as mentioned in the following, namely:-

- (i) Total marks in written test shall be 200;
- (ii) Total No. of questions in written test is 200 which shall be of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) pattern;
- (iii) There shall be negative marking for each wrong answer and for each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted from the marks awarded for correct answer.
- (iv) Qualifying mark 50% for UR & SEBC, 45% for PWD and 40% for SC and ST;

NOTE: A Sports Person to be eligible, should secure the qualifying marks of his/her category for finding place in the merit list.

- (v) Duration of Examination shall be 3 hours;
- (vi) The Syllabus shall be as per Dental Council of India (DCI) Syllabus for BDS;
- (vii) The Distribution of marks in various disciplines shall be allocated as outlined below, namely: -

The Commission shall prepare a list of candidates in order of merit on the basis of written test which shall be equal to the number of advertised vacancies.

Provided that, if two or more candidates secure equal marks, then the candidate securing higher marks in BDS Examination shall find place above the others in the merit list. In case marks obtained in BDS Examination is also the same, the candidate older in age shall be placed above the younger.

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The list recommended by the Commission shall remain valid for one year from the date of their recommendation or till the next recruitment is made by the Commission.

Note: Any details relating to this recruitment like cut-off marks, answer keys, individual marks etc. shall only be declared on the website of the Commission after publication of the final result and select list.

### 7. PLACE OF EXAMINATION:

The written examination for the post of Dental Surgeon will be held at Cuttack only. The programme of examination shall be notified well in advance.

### 8. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) The candidate must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) The candidate must be of good moral character and also be in good mental and physical condition and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of duties in the service;
- (iii) The candidate must be able to read, write and speak Odia; and must have -
  - (a) passed Middle School Examination in Odia as a language subject; or
  - (b) passed Matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as medium of examination in non-language subject; or
  - (c) passed in Odia as language subject in the final examination of Class VII or above; or
  - (d) passed a test in Odia in Middle English School standard conducted by the School and Mass Education Department.

Provided that if a candidate has not passed Middle School Examination in Odia as a language subject, he shall be required to pass the examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha within 04(four) years of joining in the service failing which no further increment shall be sanctioned nor will promotion to the rank of Group-A (Senior Branch) be made until he has passed the Odia language test.

- (iv) A candidate who has more than one spouse living, will not be eligible for appointment unless the State Government has exempted his/her case from operation of this limitation for any good and sufficient reason(s);
- (v) Government servants, whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and are within the prescribed age limit as provided under Para 3 & 4 of the Advertisement. They must inform their respective Head of Offices in writing regarding submission of their applications for this recruitment and obtain "No Objection Certificate" for submission during document verification.
- (vi) If a candidate has at any time, been debarred for a certain period/chance(s) by the Odisha Public Service Commission or other State Public Service Commission or U.P.S.C. from appearing at any examination / viva voce test, he/she will not be eligible for such recruitment for that specified period / chance(s);

- (vii) Only those candidates, who possess the requisite qualifications, are within the prescribed age limit and fulfill other eligibility conditions etc. by the closing date for submission of online application form, will be considered eligible;
- (viii) A candidate who claims change in his/her name after having passed the H.S.C. examination, is required to furnish copy of publication of the changed name in the local leading daily newspaper as well as copy of notification in the Gazette in support of his/her change of name;
- (ix) Every candidate selected for appointment shall be examined by the Medical Board. A candidate, who does not satisfy the requirement after medical examination, shall not be appointed;
- (x) Every candidate on being selected by the Commission for appointment to the Odisha Medical (Dental) Service shall serve in KBK, KBK(+) area or tribal subplan area or in such area taken together for the initial period of minimum 3 (three) years.
- (xi) Candidates who do not join the places on their posting according to sub-rules(7) and (8) shall be permanently debarred from joining service under the State Government and bond amount as executed by the candidate at the time of admission in BDS will be recovered.
- (xii) The candidates on completion of PG course, in case not served 3 years mandatory service in KBK, KBK+ or Tribal sub-plan areas must serve in those areas as stipulated under sub-rule (7) of rule-6, in case of default, the stipulation made in the rule-8(a) shall be made applicable.

### 9. IMPORTANT POINTS:

- (i) Online Applications submitted to OPSC, if found to be incomplete in any respect, are liable for rejection without entertaining any correspondence with the applicants on that score;
- (ii) A candidate found guilty of seeking support for his/her candidature by offering illegal gratification or applying pressure on any person connected with the conduct of the recruitment process or found indulging in any type of malpractice in course of the selection or otherwise, shall, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be disqualified not only for the recruitment for which he/she is a candidate, but also may be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any recruitment or selection to be conducted by the Commission;
- (iii) The provisions of the Odisha Conduct of Examination Act 1988 (Odisha Act 2 of 1988) are applicable to the examination conducted by the Odisha Public Service Commission;
- (iv) Admission to Examination will be provisional. If on verification at any stage before or after the Examination it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable to rejection. Decision of the Commission in regard to eligibility or otherwise of candidate shall be final;

- (v) This advertisement should not be construed as binding on the Government to make appointment;
- (vi) Concessions meant for S.E.B.C., S.C. & S.T. by Birth are admissible to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe of Odisha only;
- (vii) Community (Caste Status) once mentioned by the candidates shall not be changed under any circumstances.
- (viii) All persons appointed under the Government of Odisha on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2005 shall not be eligible for pension as defined under sub-rule(1) of Rule-3 of the Odisha Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1992; but shall be covered by the new structured defined Contribution Pension Scheme in accordance with the Odisha Civil Services (Pension) Amendment Rules, 2005;
- (ix) Any misrepresentation or suppression of information by the candidate in the application form will result in cancellation of his/her candidature or penalty, as decided by the Commission be imposed on the candidate.
- (x) Mere empanelment in the select list shall not confer any right for appointment unless the Government is satisfied after making such enquiry as may be deemed necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service;

# 10. <u>CERTIFICATES / DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED</u>:

Candidates who qualify in the written examination shall be required to bring with them the hard copy of online application form along with copies of following relevant certificates/documents and originals of the same for verification of their eligibility as per terms and conditions of the advertisement, the date of which will be notified later on in due course, failing which his/her application will be rejected for the said post. The candidates are required to mention on each copy of documents "Submitted by me" and put their full signature and date on the same. They must not attach the original certificates to their applications.

- (i) H.S.C. or equivalent certificate in support of declaration of age issued by the concerned Board/Council.
- (ii) B.D.S or equivalent Degree issued from the recognized University;
- (iii) Mark-list in support of all the aforesaid examinations (i.e. H.S.C. and Bachelors degree in Dental Surgery) passed including fail marks, if any, issued by the concerned Board/University;

NOTE 1: (a) Candidates who have not been awarded percentage of marks, but only "grade marks", should, along with their applications, produce the Conversion Certificate from the concerned University indicating the actual equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula, failing which, their applications are liable to be rejected.

- (b) While filling up the relevant box of the online application form, the candidate has to mention the marks secured (excepting marks secured in the Extra Optional/4<sup>th</sup> Optional Subject) in each examination passed (i.e. H.S.C. to Bachelor Degree in Dental Surgery).
- (iv) Required conversion certificates recognized by the Dental Council of India (DCI) in case of candidate having degrees from Universities of foreign countries.
- (v) Houseman-ship Completion Certificate;
- (vi) Valid Registration Certificate under the Dentist Act, 1948.
- (vii) Certificate relating to passing of the screening test conducted by the National Board of Examinations for candidates passing out of a foreign University;
- (viii) Odia test pass certificate.
- (ix) No Objection Certificate issued by the competent authority, if applicable;
- (x) Four recent passport size photographs (unsigned and unattested) with the printout / hard copy of online application form which has been uploaded.
- (xi) Caste Certificate by birth in support of claim as SEBC/ SC / ST, wherever applicable (Please see Note 2);
- (xii) Disability Certificate (indicating percentage of permanent disability) issued by the concerned Medical Board wherever applicable;
- (xiii) Sports Certificate/ Identity Card issued by the Director of Sports Odisha; wherever applicable;
- (xiv) Discharge Certificates of Ex-Serviceman issued by the Commanding Officer of the Unit last served. Ex-Servicemen should submit an affidavit undertaking that he has not been appointed against any civil post after retirement from military service, wherever applicable.
- (xv) If a candidate claims to possess qualification, claimed to be equivalent to the prescribed qualification, the rule/authority (with number and date) under which, it is so treated, must be furnished with the Application Form.
- (xvi) Any proof of identity.

## NOTE 2:

- (i) Candidates claiming to be belonging to S.E.B.C/ S.C. /S.T categories of Odisha by birth are required to submit copy of the relevant Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed form. Candidates of SEBC category (other than Creamy layer) must submit copy of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority within the last 03 years from the last date of submission of online application form in prescribed form.
- (ii) The SEBC certificate which is more than three years old by the closing date of submission of registered online application form is liable for rejection.
- (iii) Women candidates belonging to S.E.B.C./S.C./S.T. Categories are required to submit Caste Certificates by birth showing "daughter of ..........". Caste Certificates by virtue of marriage (i.e. showing "wife of ..........") are not acceptable and liable to rejection.

- (iv) OBC certificates will not be accepted in lieu of SEBC certificates and candidates submitting OBC certificates are liable for rejection.
- (v) Community (Caste status) once mentioned by the candidates shall not be changed under any Circumstances.

The competent authorities are: - District Magistrate/ Collector or Additional District Magistrate or Sub-divisional Magistrate/Sub-Collectors or Executive Magistrates or Revenue Officers, not below the rank of Tahasildar /Additional Tahasildar of Government of Odisha.

*NOTE 3*:

Degree Certificate, Houseman-ship completion Certificate, Registration certificate, Screening test certificate issued by NBE, Caste Certificate, Discharge Certificate of Ex-Servicemen, Identity Card of Sports Persons and Disability Certificate of Persons With Disabilities (indicating % of permanent disability) must have been issued by the competent authority within the last date fixed for submission of online application form.

### 11. "GROUNDS OF REJECTION OF APPLICATIONS"

Applications of candidates will be rejected by the Commission on any of the following grounds: -

- (a) In-complete online application form.
- (b) Non-submission of hard copy of online application form at the time of verification of original documents.
- (c) Not signing Declaration (full signature) in the hard copy of online application form.
- (d) Not coming within the age limit as mentioned in Para 3 of Advertisement (Overage relaxation shall not be allowed to P.W.D. candidates with less than 40% permanent disability).
- (e) Not having requisite qualification as provided under Para 4 of Advertisement.
- (f) Not furnishing copies of certificates/documents as provided under Para 10 of Advertisement.
- (g) Submission of wrong information/ false information about qualification/ Age/ Category status (SEBC/SC/ST/PWD/Ex-Servicemen/ Sports Persons /Women etc.).
- (h) Suppression of facts / information about eligibility, if any.
- (i) Any other ground as per the decision of the Commission.

NB: Application /candidature of a candidate shall be rejected at any stage of recruitment process, when discrepancy is noticed/ detected.

#### 12. HOW TO APPLY:

- (a) Candidates must go through the details of this Advertisement available in the Website of OPSC before filling up online application form.
- (b) Candidates must apply online through the concerned Website of the OPSC <a href="http://opsc.gov.in">http://opsc.gov.in</a>. Applications received through any other mode would not be accepted and summarily rejected.
- (c) Before filling up the online application form, the candidates must go through detailed instructions available at OPSC portal.
- (d) The online application form is automated and system driven & will guide the candidate seamlessly in filling the application. The requisite options shall be enabled and information shall be asked as per data furnished by the candidate. Before filling up the information, ensure that accurate information is fed, for edit option is limited & on confirmation there is no scope for further edit even if wrongful entry has been made while filling up application.
- (e) Candidates are requested to upload the scanned image of latest passport size photograph along with scanned image of his/her full signature and scanned image of Left-hand Thumb Impression (LTI) in the online application form. Uploaded photograph, Specimen (full) signature and LTI must be clearly identifiable / visible, otherwise the application of the candidate is liable to be rejected by the Commission and no representation from the candidate will be entertained.
- (f) Candidates should keep at least two copies of latest passport size photograph which is uploaded to the online application form for future use.
- (g) On successful submission of the online Registration, a unique "Permanent Public Service Account Number (PPSAN)" will be assigned to the applicant. Candidates are required to take a printout of the finally submitted Online Application forms and put his/her signature under the declaration for submission to OPSC along with copies of requisite certificate & documents as and when asked.
- (h) The candidates are advised to submit the Online Application Form well in advance without waiting for the closing date to avoid last hour rush.
- (i) Certificate of Admission to the written examination to the eligible candidates will be uploaded in the Website of the OPSC prior to the date of written examination which will be published in the Website of the Commission and Newspapers. The candidates are required to download their Admission Certificate from the Website of the Commission and produce the same at the Examination centre for admission to the written examination. No separate correspondence will be made on this score.
- (j) Any complaint on the conduct of examination must be sent to the grievance wing of the Commission by e-mail (opsc@nic.in) within 03 (Three) days of completion of the examination.
