INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Separate application along with registration fee has to be submitted for each of the posts applied for.
2. Candidate should possess the prescribed qualifications as on the date of this notification.
3. University reserves the right not to fill up all or any of the posts advertised.
4. For all the information furnished / claims made, sufficient and appropriate evidence from competent authority/self attested copies should be enclosed.
5. Physically challenged persons should furnish the Medical Certificate from District Medical Board / appropriate authority along with the application.
6. National Eligibility Test (NET) or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test SLET/SET) shall be the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor. SLET/SET shall be valid in the respective state only. However, NET qualification is relaxable for candidates having Ph.D. qualification as per UGC Rules.
7. Applicant should have valid registration with State Veterinary Council or VCI.
8. Certified copies of SSC, degree or provisional certificates and marks sheet / transcripts etc. should be enclosed to the application. The originals should be brought at the time of interview.
9. In case of Associate Professors, filled in proforma for calculation of Acad/Res score (Table XI of Regulations) and Score card for direct recruitment of Associate Professors (Table XIII of Regulations) along with verifiable evidences in sequential order with proper numbering should be enclosed.
10. Application in 06 sets should be submitted along with all enclosures including publications in A4 size in spiral bound form (including PBAS forms in case of Associate Professor)
11. While filling up the application form
 - i) If any of the applicants did their M.V.Sc. or Ph.D. by research, it should be clearly indicated.
 - ii) For details of service rendered by the applicant in different cadres, clearly mention date, month and year of appointment and scale of pay. The period of study during the service should be indicated clearly.
12. Applicants already employed in organizations other than PVNRTVU should send their applications through proper channel so as to reach the University within the prescribed date.

13. Applicants from this University should submit their applications through their respective head of the institution so as to reach the University within the prescribed date.
14. Applicants should appear for interview at their own cost.
15. Reservation in favour of Backward Classes Group-E is subject to outcome of Civil Appeal Nos.2628-2637/2010 etc. pending before the Supreme Court.
16. Selected candidates shall serve for at least six years in remote and difficult areas i.e. B & C category centers of which three years shall be in remote areas (C – class centers) and three years in backward areas (B – class centers) during the entire period of service. Failure to comply with the above rule attracts disciplinary action and disqualification for promotion etc.
17. Interview schedule shall be displayed on University website and intimation to candidate shall be sent by e-mails only.
18. Incomplete application forms are liable to be rejected.
19. The prescribed essential qualifications are minimum and possessing of same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interview. As such, the candidates for Associate Professor post are advised to fill the form carefully and each and every column of application should be filled up accurately because marks will be awarded on the basis of information supplied by them in each column.
20. In case of differently-abled persons, if candidate belonging to notified category is not available, other differently abled category candidates will be considered.
21. In respect of the posts notified to be filled with reserved categories viz., SEBC / SC/ ST, the applications of candidates native to the State of Telangana only will be considered. They should submit the relevant category certificate from competent authority of telangana state.
22. **Notification No. and Name of the post applied for should be written on the top of the envelope.**
23. Applications should be sent through Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due.
24. University will not enter into correspondence with the candidates about reasons for their non-selection for interview/appointment.

Selected candidates shall be governed by PVNRTVU Regulations and such other conditions as may be prescribed by the University from time to time. They are liable to be posted or transferred to any equivalent posts as determined by the University in Teaching, Research or Extension, in the State.

[2] For the roster points reserved to be filled with PH candidates (VH, HH, OH & MR), the candidates having less than 50% disability of Chest or spine or Lower Limb will only be considered as per MSVE 2016 regulations.

As per MSVE 2016 regulations, the candidates with the following disorders are not eligible for admission into BVSc & AH course.

- a) Disability of total body including disability of chest or spine more than 50%
- b) Disability of lower limb of more than 50%
- c) Disability of upper limb
- d) Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability
- e) Disabilities which otherwise interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

1. A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science.
2. Good academic record with at least 70% marks or an equivalent grade on a ten point scale wherever grading system is followed, at Master's Degree level in the concerned subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university shall be an essential qualification.
3. Minimum marks required in Master's degree level would be 65% or equivalent grade for candidates of SC/ST/Backward Classes/Differently-abled categories
4. For posts in various disciplines/departments the specialization at Master's level shall be in the same discipline. In addition, qualifications mentioned in table I will also be considered.
5. The National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by ICAR/UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by UGC such as State Level Eligibility Test (SLET/SET) is the minimum eligibility. Further, SLET/SET shall be valid in the respective state only.
6. Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009 or 2016 with both course work and research, and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
7. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the ICAR/UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
8. Should have passed SSC or any other equivalent Exam with Telugu as one of the subjects or should have studied SSC through medium of Telugu or should have working knowledge of Telugu.
9. The candidates should have valid registration with State Veterinary Councils/Veterinary Council of India.

B. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POST OF ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

Eligibility:

- i) A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science
- ii) Good academic record with a Master's Degree with at least 70% marks or an equivalent grade on a ten point scale wherever grading system is followed in the concerned subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Master's level for candidates belonging to categories of SC/ST/BC/ Differently-abled.
- iii) Ph.D. Degree in concerned discipline acquired by both course work and research.
- iv) A minimum of eight years of Teaching/Research/Extension experience in University system /National Level Institutions in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University or Accredited Research Institution with a minimum of seven publications in peer-reviewed /NAAS Rated or UGC-/AICTE-listed journals /SCI Journals.
- v) A total academic/research score of 75 (as per Table XI of Regulations) is essential to be eligible for interview.
- vi) Should have unblemished record of service
- vii) The candidate should have valid registration with State Veterinary Councils/Veterinary Council of India.
- viii) For posts in various disciplines/departments the specialization at Master's/Doctoral level shall be in the same discipline. In addition, qualifications mentioned in table II will also be considered.
