### CODING DISPENSATION ADOPTED FOR DIFFERENT PwBD DISABILITY CATEGORIES

<b>PwBD-1</b>	Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy
<b>PwBD-2</b>	Blindness and low vision
<b>PwBD-3</b>	Deaf and Hard of hearing
<b>PwBD-4</b>	Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness
<b>PwBD-5</b>	Multiple disabilities

### TIE –PRINCIPLES

Wherever two or more candidates have secured equal aggregate marks in ESE, 2024, the tie(s) have been resolved in accordance with the principles approved by the Commission, viz.

- (i) The candidates with more marks in subject/technical papers plus marks of Personality Test may be ranked higher;
- (ii) In case the total marks in the subject/technical papers plus marks of Personality Test are equal, the candidate who is senior in age may be ranked higher.
